

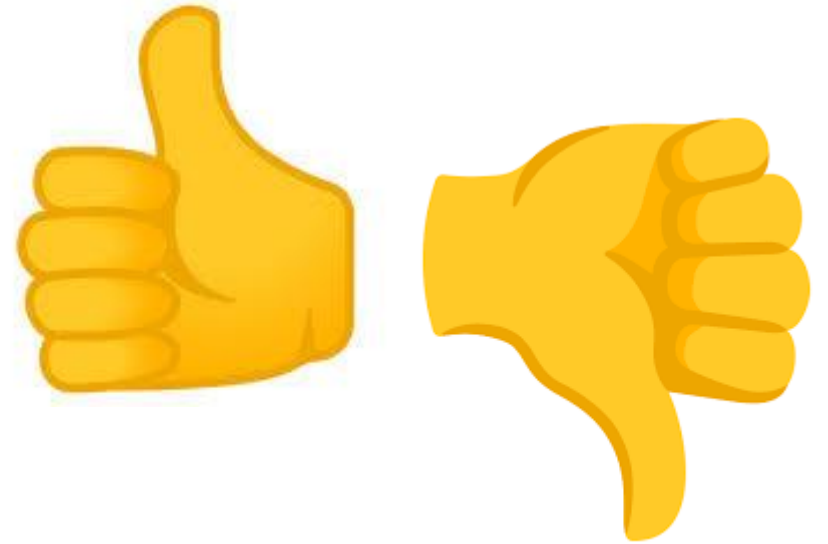

## Definition

Makes the text bigger (zoom in)

Searches a whole website

A quick way to do something using keyboard keys

Makes the text smaller (zoom out)

Finds a specific word on a web page

<b>Action</b>	<b>Shortcut</b>
Search with your default search engine	Type a search term + <b>Enter</b>
Search using a different search engine	Type a search engine name and press <b>Tab</b>
Add www. and .com to a site name, and open it in the current tab	Type a site name + <b>Ctrl + Enter</b>
Add www. and .com to a site name, and open it in a new window	Type a site name + <b>Ctrl + Shift + Enter</b>
Open a new tab and perform a Google search	Type a search term + <b>Alt + Enter</b>
Jump to the address bar	<b>Ctrl + I</b> or <b>Alt + d</b> or <b>F6</b>
Search from anywhere on the page	<b>Ctrl + k</b> or <b>Ctrl + e</b>
Remove predictions from your address bar	<b>Down arrow</b> to highlight + <b>Shift + Delete</b>
Move cursor to the address bar	<b>Ctrl + F5</b>
